Motion to approve Fundraising - Jean Hintze and Matt Rashid- Motion passed

Treasure's Report- We have about \$60,200 in our account. Motion to approve - Rob Giese and Matt Rashid. Some discussion followed. Motion passed - Suggestion made to have a budget printout passed out at the meeting - Angie Nitz will work on this. Question raised in regards to what we make on Wings Fling - Angie was able to provide some numbers for us. All good.

Freshman Orientation - Joe spoke to those who attended and shared what Oriole is all about.

Budget Requests:

- Elementary Reading Night - \$500 request to help support this event. Motion passed
- Ladies Soccer - No budget was presented this year - There is \$472 left in the soccer booster account - This year this budget is less. The team will need socks which cost \$25 a pair. A request for up to \$900 to upfront the cost of the socks with the understanding that half of this will come. Money is also needed for snacks and bananas and an end of the banquet In the future soccer will be joining ON and budget requests will be submitted for each boys and girls team (\$3000). Motion to approve this request - Jodi Giebel and Ken Giebel - motion passed.
- An idea is to approach our co-op schools to help off set some of these costs (Laconia, Oakfield, Springs etc) Jean will be our link with the Springs Booster club.
- Trap Team - Eric Morris - The kids pay \$175 to join. More equipment is needed such as shells, clay pigeons etc. 35 kids (WLA and Springs, Laconia) belong to this club. Looking for up to \$2900 . Motion to approve Aaron Sadoff and Angie Nitz - discussion - passed.
- Fishing Club - A request for a seniors only trip to Lake of the Woods MN. We currently have 2 seniors. The cost would be \$255 a piece and this is a 4 day trip and they will sleep in an ice shanty. Additional cost request for a hotel room for 1 night and MN fishing license. Motion to approve \$765 to go on this trip Doug Forsythe and Jodi Giebel - motion to amend up to \$1000 - Rob Giese and Aaron Sadoff - passed.
