You can also purchase walls (10 ft. 200) This tent appears to be easy to set up via the video. Dean suggested 2 sides and back wall - Back, 2 sides - 2 10ft. 1 20 ft. wall - roughly \$3000 - comes with stakes. We already allocate \$2000 - Doug feels comfortable to negotiate for us.

Motion to approve up to \$1200 more - Dean Witkowski and Robin Maramonte -The additional money if for adding 2 sides, 1 back wall and print on these sides.
