7:00 - Approval of the minutes from the Aug. meeting - Cindy Vandergallen. and Rob Giesse

7:01 - Treasure's report - \$58,000 is available, \$42,600 is what we have in our budgeted. Report given by Angie. All payments to Walleye Weekend are up to date. This amount does not include Oriole Open. Motion to accept report - Aaron Sadoff and Kristy Zagar. Motion passed.

7:05 - Fundraiser report -

- Walleye Weekend - We met the financial goal which was set. Thank you to everyone who helped make this a success.
- Calendars - We have sold roughly 300. Sales are up from last year. A suggestion made by Aaron is to get someone to organize the sale of the calendars. At this time we feel we need a new strategy for selling this product. This product really does more than make money for us, it promotes our district and our students as well as our sponsors. If you are interested in coordinating the sale of these please contact a member from Oriole Nation. We are encouraging members to keep selling through September.
- Oriole Open was a success. We are down about \$800. Our Thursday night event was up about 24 people. We have \$16,000 profit. This year each group will get roughly \$5000 (Oriole Nation, NFDL Pool and The Police Benevolent) .
- Buffalo Wild Wings - When you order tell them you are part of Team A. We earned \$188 last quarter. Let's keep up this support.
- The PDQ Brat Fry is coming. This event will be the Sat. Sept. 30th. Please watch for a signup sheet coming shortly.
- Drive 4UR School - We need 300 address on our sheet. Please come and drive on Wed. Sept. 13th from 3:00 - 6:00 PM in the Horace Mann Parking Lot. You only need to drive around the block. This costs us nothing. We can earn \$6000. We earn \$20 per address on the sheet. We can not have 2 drivers from the same address.
- Homecoming Party - Friday Oct. 6th beginning shortly after the parade and wrapping up around 7PM. Please come and enjoy some food and support our schools. In lieu of a football game there will be a varsity boys soccer game.

Motion to approve the Fundraising report was made by Dean Witkowski and Kristi Zagar. The motion was passed

7:20 - Volleyball requested \$78 for Teacher Appreciation T-Shirts. The game is on Thurs. Sept. 7. - A representative was asked to be present. Dean W. brought up the point that we need to be fiscally responsible. We approved \$65,730 and only have roughly \$5000 not allocated. Since no parent representative is present we decided to table this until the end of the meeting. This was done to give time for a parent representative to come.

7:23 - Chorus/Band would like new risers. The current ones are roughly 45 years old. 15 years ago 6 aluminum ones were purchased. They are asking for aluminum risers. The cost is \$686 a piece and \$200 for shipping. They would like 6 of them - 3 purchased by district and 3 by ON. Total cost would be \$4137 - half would be roughly \$2200. Proposal is that ON pay for 3 of these risers. A motion to approve this request was made by Dean Wikowski and Matt Rashid. Mr. Scudella will work with Maria from the district office to order these. Motion approved.

7:30 - We did receive \$500 from St. Mary Springs Booster Club for our wrestling mat. The wrestling program is a co-op with St. Mary Springs.

7:32 - Taxes are due again. Joe would like these in before we need to ask for an extension. We will use Huberty again. Rob. Giese. motion to use Huberty Robin Maramonte seconded Motion was passed.

7:35 - We are officially registered as a Charitable Organization.

7:35 - Concessions - All of our events are not filled. If they are not filled by the night before we will not open the concession stand. Dean put forth the idea that if your organization is not signed up for an event your group will be assigned one. We would like to make clear that we need a parent from the group there.
