Mancino Night Fundraiser - Joe mentioned this as a possible event for us. We would get 10% of the sales. We just need to pick a date, we can pick up to 5 dates. Joe will follow up on this to see what our roles would be and if this is something we would like to do.

The registration fee is \$975 and needs to be paid by March 12th 2018. They need about \$250 to take care of this payment.. Rob Guise made a motion to give them up to \$300. Robin Maramonte seconded the motion. The motion passed.

7:30 - Anthony Rasmussen gave us an update on the solo ensemble. We have over 20 plus events get a first and many are movin onto state.

Mr. Colby spoke on behalf of the Fishing Club. Earlier they were awarded \$700 from O.N. This year 40 plus students are in the club and they have been entering events every weekend.
