7:02 - Treasurers report was given by Angie Nitz. Our balance at the end of April is \$69,000 with \$22,400 not yet allocated. Minutes are accepted.

7:05 - Fund Raising

- Calendar should be done within a week. Becky Caroma is organizing the sale and distribution. There will be a sales blitz between May 14 - 25th. The sale will be from the elementary level through high school. The goal is to get the calendars into the hands of students, staff and parents. Different incentives have been set up for each academic level. Calendars will be \$20 and the payouts will be \$10 daily. This year you will see coupons: A&W, Taco Bell, Culvers, BWB, BP Car Wash, Bob's pizza, Oriole outfitters, Sportsman Club (additional \$40 value). Required by the state to do an onsite daily drawing. Weekend will be drawn on Friday. If school is not in session drawing will be done the next school day.

7:18 - Concessions report was given by Dawn Niemuth - all going well. Struggling a bit to get people in working due to all the schedule changes due to the weather. Dawn's efforts are greatly appreciated. She will get the booth set. There is a baseball tournament next weekend - May 11th - 13th. This is a large tournament. We need folks to help. Details being worked out. Dean brought forth the point about making all groups help out with concessions. More discussion will take place in the fall. Need to get through spring and then figure things out. Bert will bring this up to the varsity coaches. We really need a volunteer coordinator to assign groups to work the events. We hope to get the fall schedule out in early Aug. and assigning groups to work the games. We have roughly 100 home events per year. Expecting each club to do 3 concession events throughout the year. If you don't sign up we will assign you an event. This will apply to all groups asking for money. If your event gets cancelled and rescheduled you are still responsible for or find someone to do it. We will communicate this when we put out for budgets.

7:33 - Fishing Trailer update was given by Pat Kolby. Pat presented a few other quotes.

- Zero 4 Outdoors - \$8540
- Glacier Ice House - \$13,000,
- Core \$16299,
- Ice Castle Lake Country Neosho - \$9200 including the state title fee. (6.5 12 ft and a foot taller)

We are considering between Zero 4 Outdoors and Ice Castle. The Fishing Club could put up to \$2000 towards the purchase of a trailer. The quote from Zero 4 did not include state title fee and license fee. Those fees come to around \$100. This price valid for 30 days (May 20th). They are seeking roughly \$7200 on top of their budget. A suggestion was made to seek out fishing companies for sponsorship. Pat will follow up with this. The Fishing Club sells Battle on the Bago tickets, \$20 per ticket we get \$12 back. Battle of the Bago asked the Fishing Club if ON would be interested

in selling tickets. Oshkosh West made \$20,000 by selling these tickets, Oshkosh North made like \$8000. We would like them to come in and present to us and then decide if we will sell tickets as a fundraiser.

A motion was made to give the Fishing Club \$7200 for a trailer. The motion was made by Aaron Sadoff and Robin Maramonte. The motion passed.
