6:30 - Matt Rashid called the meeting to order. Stacy Vigil spoke to us requesting funds for her Spanish 5 students to attend Concordia Spanish Language Village and 1 night in Minneapolis. This would be a full emergent experience for them. The cost is \$260 per student for the weekend. Requesting \$150 per student for the weekend. The students would pay \$110 out of pocket. \$1500 is the full request. The students are willing to help out with concessions in the fall to put in some time to Oriole Nation. Rob Giese made a motion to pay \$150 per student not to exceed \$1500. Motion passed. Have fun!

6:40 - Matt Rashid made a motion to approve the Minutes from our April meeting - Aaron Sadoff and Rob Giese made the motion. Our April minutes were accepted.

6:41 : \$67000 are in the bank, some of these funds are sponsorship for next year. Our balance is 58,000 for this year. Currently we have \$8000 not allocated. Nicki Willner and Rob Giese made and the motion to accept the treasurer's report. The report was accepted.

6:45 - Fund Raising - Aaron Sadoff presented.

- Calendars are here and are for sale. The cost is \$20 per calendar.
- Oriole Open is ready to register teams. Please get names to Aaron so he can save your team a spot.
- Walleye Weekend - Matt Rashid presented. Looks like all is set to go. Matt shared out some new products that would be sold at the event. DD's Barbeque will be partnering with us.
- Volunteerspot will be up and running soon for Walleye weekend.

6:50 - Concessions - Aaron shared that all is good at this time. Nothing new to report.

6:50 - HUDL - Matt Bertrum - Matt Bertrum was here in April requesting \$5000 from ON to support an upgrade to our current HUDL subscription. ON asked him to research more and come back in May. He shared that he learned about a variety of competitors to HUDL. DV sports - geared towards football, Krossover Digital geared towards soccer and basketball. This past year we paid \$1800 for us to use HUDL - silver level. This was used by basketball, football and wrestling. For our subscription to stay status que for fall we would be paying \$2300 (basketball, wrestling, football) , \$400 more for volleyball and maybe for powerlifting. Add \$800 for 2 more teams (\$3100) Current package allows you to tape the game/match and download it and watch it. Students can cut clips and make a highlight tape. Coaches have to do all the breakdown work under this package.

New rule for Flyaway Conference - Football and Basketball all team need to share their games with their conference games.

HUDL Assist - Here is what HUDL Assist would do: Break down the game stat by stat per player. The company does this for the coaches. The turn around is between 12 - 24 hours. It can get player specific. Ala Carte - Boys and Girls BB and VB - (mounted camera) \$8500.

District package \$8000 - add as many sports as he wants at middle school and high school levels. Can use this to record some of our band and chorus and play etc if they do them in the gym where the camera is. (call them All Stars). FB, Soccer, VB, BB.

- Currently HUDL is paid for out of the Athletic Budget.
- \$1800 would still be from the Athletic Dept.
- VB, BB said they would give money out of their budgets, FB will contribute too.
- \$4500 request from ON -
- More and more schools are using HUDL Assist. Matt believes most other school have booster clubs that pay for it.
- Yearly subscription. (Hudl Assist, camera, add any sport to the program)
- \$1700 Deficit will come out of the sports budgets provided by the district. Football willing to use \$1000 of their district budget.
- Without camera \$7200 -
- **Asking for a one year trial**
- We can split up our payments - Matt said our first payment would not be due until Nov (ON portion). District would pay their portion first for the 19-20 year.

Motion made by Rob Giese to give up to \$4500 towards the HUDL District program, a payment plan will be determined at a later date. **This is a one year trial.** Michael Zagar seconded the motion. Motion passed.
