Daily Schedule:

Due to this streamlined summer school schedule, schedules will vary depending on classes.

Band preparation and athletic training courses will have schedules determined by individual instructors and these dates/time will be directly communicated to students. Also, see the forms below for band preparation classes.

Students in Grades 6-12 attending summer school to satisfy credit or course completion will also have their schedule arranged by instructors, ranging between 8:00am–3:30pm

Locations:

- Bessie Allen School (BA): MS Band and MS Strength/Conditioning
- Horace Mann High School (HM): HS Band, HS Remediation (specific room) and Practice Fields
- Early Learning Center: “Getting Ready for” Classes in Specific Rooms

REGISTRATION

**To register, stop into Friendship Learning Center during school hours from April 2nd – April 27th.*

All Students of the School District of NFDL, both of public and private, are welcome to attend summer school. Due to the class size and space concerns due to construction, no visitors will be allowed. In addition, there will be changes to drop off/pick up/parking locations. Please do not park in the front lot next to BAMS/HMHS. Parents are to drop off/pick up/park at ELC's lot, by the pool area, or the area behind HMHS.

When registering, use the registration form on page 3 of this booklet. One form should be submitted for each child in a family. Registration forms should be returned to Kathy Rashid at FLC by **April 27th**. The emergency form must also be filled out (one for each child) and brought to registration. *Classes are arranged and staff employed on the basis of sufficient registration numbers. The number of students registered for a class determines what classes are offered.*

FREE BREAKFAST AND LUNCH

Our District has qualified for a federal grant that will allow all students to receive a breakfast and lunch at no cost. This will start on June 11 and last until July 27. **Breakfast will be offered from 7:30am-9:00am and lunch will be served 11:30am-1:00pm.**

Track A Courses (June 11 - July 27)

Course #: 13 **Course Name:** Middle School Strength & Conditioning
Grade Level: 6th-8th **Time:** 4:00-5:00pm **Instructor:** Yanke **Fee:** none
