School Board Election Information

The District has 8 candidates for 3 open seats on the Board of Education. Due to election laws, there will be a Primary Election held on Tuesday, February 15th, 2022 in all District municipalities to narrow the field to 6 candidates for the Regular Election on Tuesday, April 5th, 2022. The Board currently consists of Peter Chisholm (not running for re-election), Stephen Hock, Vickie Goldapske, Terry Jaeger (seat up for election) and Jonathan Goeckerman (seat up for election).
