Referral Process

Parent/Guardian Referral

Parent/guardian is interested in their child starting mental health therapy in the Oriole Nation Heals



Parent/guardian calls their child's school counselor who will collect the contact information and refer to the mental health navigator.

OR

Parent calls Oriole Nation Heals Line. A meeting is scheduled with the parent/guardian and mental health navigator to complete the necessary paperwork for their child to begin services.



The mental health navigator will call the provider that was selected by parent/guardian and set up intake/first therapy appointment. Parent/guardian will be notified of the date and time of the first appointment.



Parent/Guardian may be asked to attend the intake appointment with their child.

School District Staff Referral

School personnel along with Student Concern Team, SEL Team or PLC identifies that a student would benefit from mental health therapy in Oriole Nation Heals



Administrator, school counselor or school nurse completes a staff referral form and submits to school counselor.



School counselor contacts parent/guardian to discuss program and gauge interest in the program.



If interest in the program, school counselor refers to the mental health navigator. Parent/guardian will be contacted by mental health navigator to schedule a meeting to complete paperwork for child to begin program. Assistance in filling out forms will be given if needed.



The mental health navigator will call the provider selected by parent/guardian to set up intake/first therapy appointment. Parent/guardian will be notified of the date and time for the first appointment.



Parent/guardian may be asked to attend the intake appointment with their child.
