Election Details

An election is to be held in the School District of North Fond du Lac, on Tuesday, April 1, 2025. The following offices are to be elected to succeed the present incumbents listed.

Incumbent and Office held:

Jonathan Goeckerman, School Board Member Jacob Huempfner, School Board Member Terry Jaeger, School Board Member

The two candidates who receive the highest number of votes will fill the full-term board seats. The candidate who gets the third most votes will fill the remainder of the board seat that had been affected by a vacancy (and that is currently being held by an appointee).

Office Terms

The term of office for the two school board members with the highest votes is three years beginning on Monday, April 28, 2025.

The term of office for the one school board member with the third most votes is one year beginning on Monday, April 28, 2025.

For Candidates

A Campaign Registration Statement and a Declaration of Candidacy, must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, January 7, 2025, in the District Office located at 1115 Thurke Avenue NFDL, WI 54937.

Primary Election

If a primary is necessary, the primary will be held on Tuesday, February 18, 2025.

Acceptable Photo ID will be required to vote at this election. If you do not have a photo ID you may obtain a free ID for voting from the Division of Motor Vehicles.
