SLO Examples:

- *Growth Goal*

By May of 2019, 100% of my students will demonstrate one-year of worth of growth in reading as evidenced by the grade level equivalency (GE) measure in STAR Reading.

By May of 2019, 100% of my students will demonstrate appropriate growth (see tiers) in analyzing & citing strong textual-evidence as evidenced by my teacher created assessment.

- Tier I - Below-Basic range will move into Basic/Proficient/Advanced range
- Tier II - Basic range will move into Proficient/Advanced range
- Tier III - Proficient range will move into Advanced range
- Students in Advanced range will show evidence of learning within advanced range

- *Achievement Goal*

By the end of 1st semester, 80% of my students will be proficient or advanced in writing informational essays as evidenced by our teacher created assessments.

By May of 2019, 85% of my students will be proficient or advanced in reading readiness skills as evidenced by our reading readiness assessment.
