Your child has the opportunity to participate in FLC's **E3 Academy**. The 21st CCLC is a competitive federal grant awarded to the School District of North Fond du Lac for the specific purpose of providing educational activities and improving academic performance to Kindergarten through fifth grade students. "The vision of the E3 Academy or 21st Century Community Learning Centers' Grant is to provide blended academic and recreational activities to Kindergarten through 5th grade students in a safe and nurturing environment." 1. Hours and Start Date: September 13th, 2021

- **Monday-Friday 7:15 a.m. -8:30 a.m.**
- **Monday-Friday 3:45 p.m. - 5:15 p.m.**

2. Breakfast & Snack

- The District will provide a healthy after school snack and water will be the only liquid available.
- All students will be offered breakfast in their classroom free of charge.

3. Programming

- Your child will engage in academic activities, as well as physical activity and social/emotional learning.
- The E3 Academy does take local field trips into the community often. All of these trips take place during the afternoon hours of the program.
- Students are typically grouped according to grade level, however, at times they will be with the larger group which will range from Kindergarten-5th Grade
- Students need to be present for the entire session in which they register for. This is critical for our attendance records and also to ensure a safe arrival and departure.

4. Drop off/Pick Up

- Drop off time for the morning session is 7:15 a.m. and pick up time for the afternoon session is 5:15 p.m.

Students should be dropped off and picked up using the front door entrance. Prompt drop off and pick up is required.
